

### ***Exim configuration***

- Single master configuration file
  - /usr/local/etc/exim/configure (FreeBSD port)
  - /usr/exim/configure (if installing from source)
- Controls the decision-making and delivery process
- Very flexible expression language
  - Can be configured to look up data in external tables or databases
- Basic default configuration
  - /etc/aliases, forward, mbox delivery for system accounts, relaying control

### ***Changing the configuration***

- Test it after making changes
  - if you wish, can prepare a new file and test it with `exim -C configfile ...`
- You need to "HUP" the exim daemon to make it re-read its config file
  - `cat /var/run/exim.pid`
  - send this process a "HUP" signal
  - `kill -1 n`
  - or: `kill -HUP n` (*same thing*)
