## Exim configuration

- Single master configuration file
   /usr/local/etc/exim/configure (FreeBSD port)
   /usr/exim/configure (if installing from source)
   Controls the decision-making and delivery process

- Very flexible expression language
   Can be configured to look up data in external tables or databases
   Basic default configuration
   /etc/aliases, forward, mbox delivery for system accounts, relaying control

## Changing the configuration

- Test it after making changes
  if you wish, can prepare a new file and test it with
  exim-C configfile ....
  You need to "HUP" the exim daemon to make
- it re-read its config file
- cat /var/run/exim.pid
- send this process a "HUP" signal
- kill -1 n
- or. kill -HUP n (same thing)
